

Sundry Baseball League Constitution

Name & Purpose

Sundry Baseball League

The purpose of this league is to play baseball games at a fun level and get out of the house, socialize, and have fun.

Membership

The league is open to all people over the age of 16 and under the age of 100.

Any person under 16 has to be identified and agreed upon by the opposing team before the game starts.

Executive Authority

The ruling body of the league will consist of a board of governors (Executive) with the following positions: president, secretary, treasurer, tournament committee, social committee, diamond committee.

Elections will be held at the meeting in the fall. Open positions will be filled.

The Executive can change any rules with a minimum of 51% votes of those present.

League meetings will be held in the spring and fall as required. Each team must have a representative attend every meeting. Teams that miss a scheduled meeting will be fined, with all fines payable to the treasure prior to the tournament. Penalties are as follows: first missed meeting—\$50; second missed meeting—\$100; third missed meeting—removal from the league. Missed meetings accumulate across seasons beginning April 22, 2009. Teams removed from the league for missed meetings are not eligible for a refund of league fees.

New teams – the executive has first right of refusal and will decide which team will join the league if there is more than one team interested.

Amendments to the Constitution

The Executive can change any item or add to the league constitution at any time with a vote of 51% of those present.

Playing rules

League rules and tournament rules will be reviewed yearly and agreed upon by all teams.

Harassment and Violence Policy

Zero Tolerance Policy: Violence, harassment, discrimination, or abusive conduct of any kind is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate removal and possible suspension or expulsion. Any person found with a weapon at a league event will be permanently banned, in accordance with the Criminal Code of Canada (effective October 18, 2017). Team Captains are responsible for enforcement, and all violations must be reported to the League President immediately

League termination

If the league folds/terminates, all money in the bank will be divided equally amongst current teams.
